Culture and Scenery

An interesting route whose first destination is the municipality of Lluc, where you can appreciate the beauty of its XIII century sanctuary. It then continues to Caimari, whose historical interest is widely recognised, and which boasts an Ethnological Park which is well worth visiting.

The route continues towards Campanet, with its caves which are almost 400 metres long and always impress visitors. This route ends back where it started in

Ruta Route 2 Cala Sant Vicenç





The charming north of the island

Just 30 minutes from Port de Pollença, Cala Sant Vicenç is a fine example of the charms of Majorca's north coast.


Its main appeal is its four beaches:

Cala Barques, with fine white sand, is also the best place to appreciate one of Cala Sant Vicenç's most beautiful features, known as "Es Cavall Bernat" (Bernat the Horse), Cala Clara, Cala Molins, and Cala Carbó, which is covered in boulders and pebbles.

These coves can be reached from one road next to the sea.

Ruta Cap de Formentor





An impressive site

Port de Pollença is an attractive fishing port in the north of the island, and is also one of the most historic ports of the Mediterranean, as many different civilizations have passed through there. It is an ideal starting point for the route towards Formentor along a road that follows the peninsula's coastline with constant views of the sea cliffs.

The route ends at the spectacular and beautiful Cap de Formentor cape, which is a unique spot for watching migrating birds. You can also admire the famous lighthouse, which is visited by thousands of tourists every year.

Ruta Route 4 La Calobra







Cliffs and Sea

This impressive route to **Ia Calobra** takes you into the **Serra de Tramuntana** mountain range to enjoy the immense beauty of its landscape, which is formed by valleys, forests of holm oak and high peaks.

During the section by road, you go through one of the arches of the magnificent Turixant aqueduct, continuing down round hairpin bends that take you to la Calobra cove. This is where the mouth of the Torrent de Pareis is located. flanked by rocky elevations that reach up 200 metres above sea level. It is considered one of the most spectacular spots in the north of the island, From sa Calobra, the return journey takes you towards Lluc, where the monastery, with its beautiful architecture and important history, is well worth a visit. Returning to Pollenca you'll have the opportunity to visit traditional towns in the north of the Island such as Caimari, Moscari and Campanet.
